## ANNUAL FINANCE REPORT

The balance in the accounts stood at $\mathbf{£ 1 1 , 2 1 4}$ at the $31^{\text {st }}$ March 2018. The breakdown of funds is shown below.

The income for the full year is $£ 7,675$ with expenditure of $£ 1,098$ and grants of $£ 13,280$ leading to a net outflow of $\mathbf{£ 6 , 7 0 2}$.

There is no annual report required by the Charities Commission because the income for the year is less than $£ 10,000$.

This year we held one metal detecting event as the main fundraiser.
We gave two grants to the PCC - $£ 7,780$ in May 2017 for electrical work and $£ 5,500$ in January 2018 for the remaining projects for which the funding was approved by trustees (parclose screen, Doom painting and CCTV).
