## Friends of St Mary's Bacton Treasurer's Report – Accounts to January 2009 11<sup>th</sup> February 2010

## **Summary for current year**

The balance in the accounts stands at £13,705 at the end of January. This figure includes cheques totalling £1,140 recently banked for the metal detecting day. £10,000 is held in the investment account with £3,705 in the current account.

In addition to the metal detecting income, other movements in the month have been a small amount of interest income on the deposit account (£20), further income from card sales (£20), usual standing orders (£59) and an expense of £40 for carol service wine from Bacton Stores.

Total income in the year to date is £6,199 with expenses of £11,658, resulting in a net outflow of £5,460.
