

Friends of St Mary's Bacton Treasurer's Report – March 2018

Summary for the 12 months to the end of March 2018

The balance in the accounts stood at **£11,214** at the 31st March 2018. The breakdown of funds is shown below.

The income for the year is £7,675 with expenditure of £1,098 and grants of £13,280 leading to a **net outflow of £6,702**.

During January, a grant of £5,500 was made to the PCC Fabric fund. All funds allocated to specific projects have now been distributed. The remaining balance is unallocated. Gift Aid tax relief of £347 was received in March.
