

# Friends of St Mary's Bacton Treasurer's Report – January 2025

## Summary to the end of January 2025

The balance in the accounts stood at **£12,599** of which £12,522 is in bank accounts and £76 is in petty cash.

The income for the year to date is £4,248 with expenditure of £971 leading to a net inflow of **£3,277**.

I have paid £324 to the PCC Fabric Fund to cover the invoice from Fran Adnams for her report.

We have received the first notification of charges on the account following Lloyds' decision to start charging for certain types of transaction. The £3 shown in the summary table above relates to paying in £401 in cash at the Post Office from the Christmas Concert. This equates to 0.75% which is less than half the handling fee that SumUp (and other card services) charge.

Our lottery license is due for renewal by 29<sup>th</sup> March at a cost of £20, so I will be renewing that in due course.
